Sports Premium: - £8,720

Curriculum

- £550 Youth Sport Trust Membership - Rochdale Borough School Games Partnership work to provide lots of sporting opportunities for the development of PE skills. They also provide specialist training for PE staff. Initial teacher training support provided to a PE specialist to work with a range of year groups to develop practice.
- Tennis Coaching for all Year Groups - Link4Life (Sylvia Decker).
- Access to the local tennis courts (Middleton Tennis Club) all year round to signpost school children to community tennis.
- Intensive football coaching provided for all year groups - Rochdale Football Club come into school for one week in the autumn term and work with the children to develop football skills.
- Funding for HLTA management responsibility to oversee and develop PE provision both in and out of school in partnership with the PE subject leader. This year the emphasis has been on providing as many opportunities for children to take part in a range of sports, i.e. water polo, athletics, badminton, basketball.

Extra-Curricular

- Specialist Dance Coaching - Shannon Hornibrook.

- Swim Club - This year we have engaged the support of a Paralympian Swim Coach (Natalie Massey) to develop the skills and technique of our less-able swimmers.

At Middleton Parish we already provide a wide range of sports coaching for the children to access both within and out of curriculum time. All of our children say that they enjoy their PE lessons and the sports clubs are well attended. We have managed to build on this success.
