## Report on Principles, Spend and Impact of Pupil Premium Grant 2014-2015

The pupil premium is additional funding for publicly funded schools in England to raise the **attainment** of disadvantaged pupils and close the gap between them and their peers.

### Principles

As a Church school our ethos is firmly rooted in gospel values with love being the foundation of everything we do. We recognise that our children are made in the image of God and possess unique gifts and qualities. So:

- We strive to ensure that the impact of our teaching enables all children to make appropriate levels of progress throughout school
- We already target children who may require additional support in Maths and English

In the 2014 to 2015 financial year, we received funding for each child registered as eligible for free school meals at any point in the last 6 years. We also received funding for any child who had received Local Authority Care.

### Nature of support 2014/15

- Eligible children received full subsidies to enable them to go to a residential outdoor activity
- Articles of school uniform were subsidised
- Subsidised music lessons for eligible children
- Whole school music tuition given to all children
- Sports trips funded
- Music trips funded
- School trips/visitors to school subsidised
- Learning mentor salary

### Impact of support

- All children who want to go on residential trips are able to go

- All children have appropriate winter clothing
- All children have had the opportunity to perform in a large venue(RAH,London)
- Impact of funding on Progress:
  - 100% of PP children made expected progress in writing and maths,
  - 86% in Reading.
  - 71% made more than expected progress in Reading
  - 43% made more than expected progress in writing
  - 57% made more than expected progress in maths
  - More of our PP children made more than expected progress than national average for all children.
