Dear Parent/Carer,

Welcome back, I hope you have had a good summer break. There are a few matters I need to bring to your attention as we begin this academic year: -

- All children will be expected to wear PE kit for training sessions; this includes the girls who will be attending netball training in the morning. Where possible, the girls should come to school in their PE kit with their school uniform in a bag. This should be left in the spare classroom in the lodge. If they are unable to come to school in their PE kit, they should get changed in the spare classroom in the lodge.
- In our continued drive to attain outstanding status, we have produced a 'Code of Conduct' which we require both parents and children to sign.
- When we have matches at Parish, the children will be expected to meet in the spare classroom in the lodge where they should get changed.
