

Sports 'Code of Conduct' (Children) 2015/16

As a member of Middleton Parish School Teams, you are expected to abide by the following rules: -

- ❖ You should keep to the agreed times for training and inform your coach by 9:15 at the latest, if you're going to be late, absent or can't make a match.
- ❖ You must play within the rules and respect the decisions of the coach and other officials, i.e. you must not disagree with any decisions made.
- ❖ You must respect other opponents, recognising fair play and good performance.
- ❖ You should wear your school P.E. kit for training, unless otherwise stated by the coach.
- ❖ You must have your hair tied back and off your face whilst taking part in any sporting activities. Jewellery must **not** be worn; if stud earrings cannot be removed they must be covered with plasters. Girls participating in netball will be expected to keep their nails short.
- ❖ Good behaviour, which ensures the safety of all, should be demonstrated at all times. If your behaviour is deemed inappropriate, a sanction will be given, which may include being asked to come off the field of play for the rest of the match.
- ❖ You must remember when representing Parish that you are in the care of school staff until the event is finished and the sporting equipment has been tidied away, at which time you will be handed over to their parents.

As a parent/guardian of a child taking part in Extra Curricular/Sporting activities at Middleton Parish School, I am happy to support the following code of conduct: -

- ❖ I will help my child to recognise good performance in play and not just the results.
- ❖ I will set a good example at all times, and applaud the good performance of all.

- ❖ I will accept the decisions from officials and not comment negatively even if I disagree.
- ❖ I will support my child's involvement and help them to enjoy sporting/extra-curricular activities.
- ❖ I will use appropriate language at all times and be a good role model.

Please remember that when your child is practising or representing Parish that they are in the care of school staff until the event is finished and the sporting equipment has been tidied away. Children will be dismissed together unless there is a special circumstance which means that your child needs to be taken away quickly once the activity has finished; this should be communicated to the coach before the activity begins.

If you are unable to support this 'Code of Conduct', we will ask that you do not attend extra-curricular events.
